Over the past five years, the United States has provided nearly fifty billion dollars for the relief and reconstruction of Iraq. Did the U.S. rebuilding program achieve its objectives? 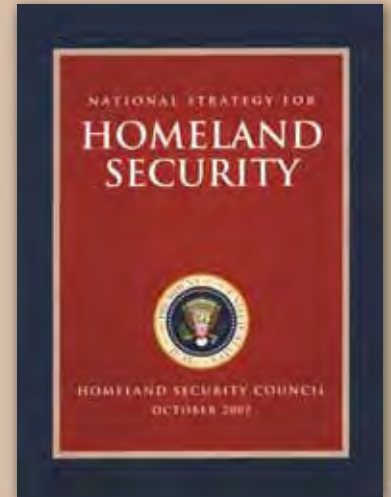
